

Bag Learning Terms and Conditions

PLEASE READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THE BAG LEARNING PLATFORM.

1. Introduction and Acceptance of Terms

Welcome to Bag Learning! These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the Bag Learning website, platform, mobile applications (if any), and related services (collectively, the "Service"), provided by **Bag Learning (Pty) Ltd**, a private company registered in South Africa ("Bag Learning", "we", "us", "our").

By creating an account, accessing, or using the Service, you agree to be bound by these Terms, our **Privacy Policy**, and our **Pricing and Refund Policy** (all incorporated herein by reference). If you do not agree to these Terms, you may not access or use the Service.

These Terms constitute a legally binding agreement between you and Bag Learning.

2. Eligibility

To use the Service, you must:

- Be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- Be an actively enrolled student at a recognized tertiary educational institution.
- Have the legal capacity to enter into a binding contract.

By creating an account and using the Service, you represent and warrant that you meet these eligibility requirements.

3. Service Description

Bag Learning provides an Al-powered educational tool designed to assist tertiary students in South Africa with their studies. The Service uses artificial intelligence, including integrations with third-party Large Language Models (LLMs) like Google Gemini, to process materials you provide ("Input") and generate study aids such as

personalized notes, summaries, quizzes, and exam simulations ("Output"). The Service is intended as a supplementary learning tool to support your academic efforts.

4. Account Registration and Security

- Account Creation: You must register for an account to access the paid features
 of the Service. You agree to provide accurate, current, and complete
 information during registration and to keep your account information updated.
- Credentials: You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your account password and are solely responsible for all activities that occur under your account. You agree not to share your account credentials with any third party.
- Unauthorized Use: You must notify us immediately at support@baglearning.com of any unauthorized use of your account or any other breach of security. Bag Learning will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to comply with these security obligations.

5. Fees, Payment, Subscription, and Refunds

Access to the features of the Service requires a paid subscription or purchase. All fees, payment terms, subscription details (including the Launch Special Offer valid until 31 July 2025), billing cycles, renewal conditions, cancellation rights, and specific refund conditions (including the "Study Smarter — Or Your Money Back" Guarantee for the Launch Special Offer) are detailed in our separate **Pricing and Refund Policy**, which is incorporated by reference into these Terms.

- **Your Input:** You retain all pre-existing intellectual property rights, including copyright, in the original content, data, prompts, and materials you upload or provide to the Service ("Input").
- Al-Generated Output: As between you and Bag Learning, you are granted and assigned all rights, title, and interest in and to the specific Output generated by the Service directly from your Input.

- License Grant to Bag Learning: You grant Bag Learning a limited, non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide license to use, reproduce, process, adapt, and display your Input solely for the purposes of:
 - Operating, providing, and improving the core functionality of the Service requested by you (i.e., generating your Output).
 - Maintaining and securing the Service.
 - Complying with legal obligations. Crucially, this license does NOT
 permit Bag Learning to use your Input or Output, in any form (including
 anonymized or aggregated), to train its own or any third-party artificial
 intelligence models. We are fundamentally committed to not training
 our models on your content.
- Your Warranty: You represent and warrant that you own your Input or have obtained all necessary rights, licenses, consents, and permissions to provide the Input to the Service and to grant the license described above, and that your Input does not infringe upon the intellectual property rights or any other rights of any third party.

 - Infringes upon any third party's intellectual property rights (copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret) or other proprietary rights.
 - Is defamatory, libelous, obscene, pornographic, abusive, harassing, threatening, or otherwise objectionable.
 - o Contains viruses, malware, or other harmful code.
 - o Constitutes hate speech or promotes discrimination or violence.



- Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise attempt to discover the source code or underlying algorithms of the Service.
- Modify, adapt, translate, or create derivative works based on the Service (other than the Output generated for your use).
- Sell, resell, rent, lease, sublicense, or otherwise commercially exploit the Service or access to it.
- Use any automated means (bots, scrapers) to access the Service, other than through official APIs if provided by Bag Learning.

11. Termination

- **Termination by You:** You may terminate your account and these Terms at any time by ceasing to use the Service and contacting us at support@baglearning.com to request account deletion. Refund eligibility upon termination is governed by our Pricing and Refund Policy.
- Termination by Bag Learning: We may suspend or terminate your access to the Service and these Terms, with or without cause, at any time upon notice to you. Grounds for termination may include, but are not limited to, (i) breach of these Terms (including the AUP), (ii) non-payment of fees, (iii) prolonged inactivity (e.g., 12 months or more), (iv) requests by law enforcement or government agencies, or (v) discontinuance or material modification of the Service.

If you do not agree to the modified Terms, you must stop using the Service.

13. Governing Law

These Terms and any disputes arising out of or related to them or the Service shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of South Africa, without regard to its conflict of law principles.

14. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to these Terms, or the breach, termination, or invalidity thereof, shall be submitted exclusively to the competent courts located in the Republic of South Africa.

15. Notice and Takedown Procedure (User Input)



Bag Learning respects intellectual property rights. As Bag Learning is not currently a member of an Industry Representative Body recognised under the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act 25 of 2002 (ECTA), we do not benefit from the specific intermediary liability limitations ("safe harbors") provided in Chapter XI of ECTA. However, we provide the following procedure for reporting allegedly unlawful **Input** provided by users:
